★ For burnable rubbish, please use designated rubbish bags, write your name and neighbourhood on the bag, and put it at the burnable rubbish collection station by 8 am on the day of collection.

★ Please do not put your rubbish out at night. You will disturb the people living nearby.

Collection dates for non-burnable rubbish (metal, glass), oversize rubbish (burnable and non-burnable), recyclable rubbish, and special rubbish collection dates.

**Any metal that is not collected as recycling, i.e. not food or drink containers*

★ Please place metal items, glass items, ceramics, and plastic containers and wrapping in designated bags issued by the town, and attach a designated sticker issued by the town to oversize rubbish. You must write your name and neighbourhood on all bags and stickers, and put them at your non-burnable rubbish collection station by 8 AM on the day they are due to be collected.

★ Please place recyclable rubbish at your apartment or neighbourhood association recycled rubbish collection station.

★ Don't put your rubbish out at night. Incorrectly sorted rubbish and raw garbage causes problems for the people who live near the rubbish collection stations.

★ Rubbish collection and sorting stations are the responsibility of the apartment management or neighbourhood association.

The following 15 items are collected as recyclable rubbish, and must be separated:

- 1) Steel cans
- 2) Aluminium cans
- 3) Clear plastic PET bottles
- 4) Coloured or other non-clear plastic PET bottles
- 5) Clear, transparent glass bottles
- 6) Brown glass
- 7) Other coloured glass
- 8) Recyclable glass (usually brown beer bottles and large sake bottles that will be reused.)
- 9) Cardboard Boxes
- 10) Newspapers
- 11) Magazines (including advertising material inside newspapers)
- 12) Cartons for milk, juice etc.
- 13) Any other containers or packaging made of paper
- 14) Waste cooking oil
- 15) Old clothes

- Cans (food cans only)
 - Rinse with water, do not crush.
 - Do not put out cans that have had oil in them.
- Plastic PET bottles (food/drink bottles only)
 - Rinse with water, do not crush.
 - Do not remove the label.
 - Put the cap in the 'plastic containers & wrapping' bag.
- Glass bottles (for food use only. Glass apart from bottles cannot be disposed of by the city.)
 - Rinse with water.
 - Do not remove the label.
 - Bottles that have had oil in them cannot be recycled.
 - Broken bottles are also accepted.
 - Please remove any caps or lids.
- Paper items (stack and tie together with string)
 - Paper cartons for milk and juice etc. can be recycled, but they must not have aluminium coating on the inside, and they must be bigger than 500 millilitres.
 - Please remove any tape or anything else stuck to cardboard boxes as best as possible

- Waste cooking oil (oil for machinery cannot be disposed of by the city)
 - Please put in empty plastic PET bottles with the cap fastened.
- Old clothes
 - Please wash before putting out for collection.
 - Please do not remove buttons or zips.
 - Please put wet, extremely dirty (for example with paint or oil), damaged or extremely smelly clothes out with the burnable rubbish.
 - Please put them out in a clear plastic bag so that the contents are visible but cannot get wet.

Rubbish not accepted by the local government

We do not dispose of the following waste. Please take them to a dealer or discuss what to do with a specialist.

The following four types of electrical appliance- Braun tube, LCD or plasma televisions; air conditioners; refrigerators and freezers; washing machines and dryers.

Petroleum (gasoline, benzene, thinner etc.), kerosene, waste oil, fireworks, explosives, large quantities of flares, toner, large amounts of vegetation, tires, motorbikes, engines, car batteries, motors, mopeds, agricultural equipment with an engine, fire extinguishers, paint, cans that have had paint in them, bathtubs, septic tanks, propane gas, compressed gas cylinders, fire-proof safes, pianos, bowling balls, agricultural chemicals, insecticide, containers with medicine inside them, syringes, containers for poisonous substances, glass syringes, drip tubes, test tubes, excrement, mud, animal carcasses, steel frames any bigger than 5 mm thick, 4 cm wide and 1 m long, anything that may cause a fire or explosion, iron any bigger than 6 mm thick, 30 cm wide, and 50 cm long, medicine, medical waste, large amounts of wooden blocks or other scrap wood bigger than 10 cm in diameter or 1 meter in length, electric bicycles, anything that cannot be crushed, etc.
